

D+EA Undergraduate Student Achievement Data

Job Placement:

- Of the 2015 D+EA graduates who actively pursued employment, 80% were employed by the end of August 2015. Internships and permanent placement is aided at the university, college and departmental levels: <http://dea.human.cornell.edu/placements>

Acceptance into Graduate Programs:

- Three students from the graduating class of 2015 applied to and were accepted into graduate school. This is a 100% acceptance rate.
- During the past five years (2011-2015) nearly 14% of D+EA graduates pursued advanced degrees after completing their undergraduate degree at Cornell

Graduation Rates:

- 100% of the students from the class of 2015 graduated in 4 years.
- 96% of the students from the class of 2014 graduated in 4 years.
- 96% of the students from the class of 2013 graduated in 4 years.
- 100% of the students from the class of 2012 graduated in 4 years.
- 92% of the students from the class of 2011 graduated in 4 years.

Attrition Rates:

- For the AY 2014-2015: the attrition rate was 1.02%.
- For the AY 2013-2014: the attrition rate was 1.19%.
- For the AY 2012-2013: the attrition rate was 2.44%.
- For the AY 2011-2012: the attrition rate was 2.20%.
- For the AY 2010-2011: the attrition rate was 3.16%.
